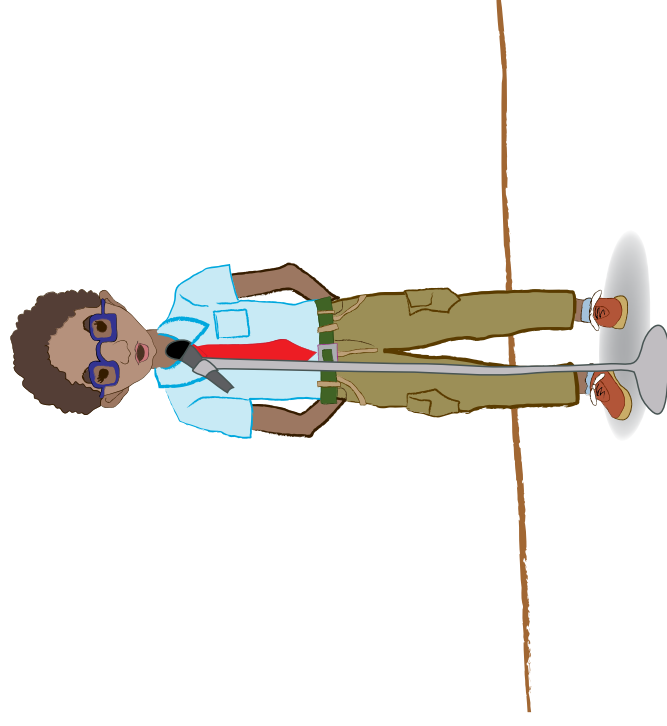


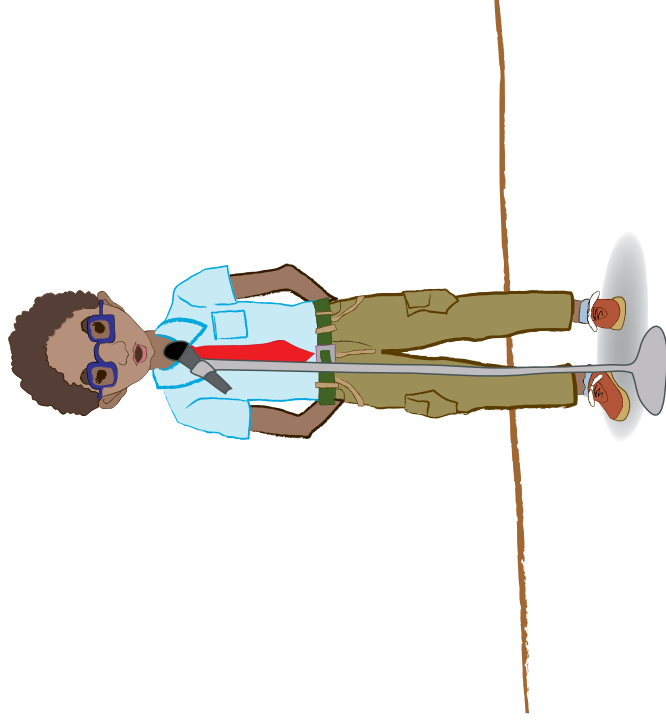

head. He was ready.

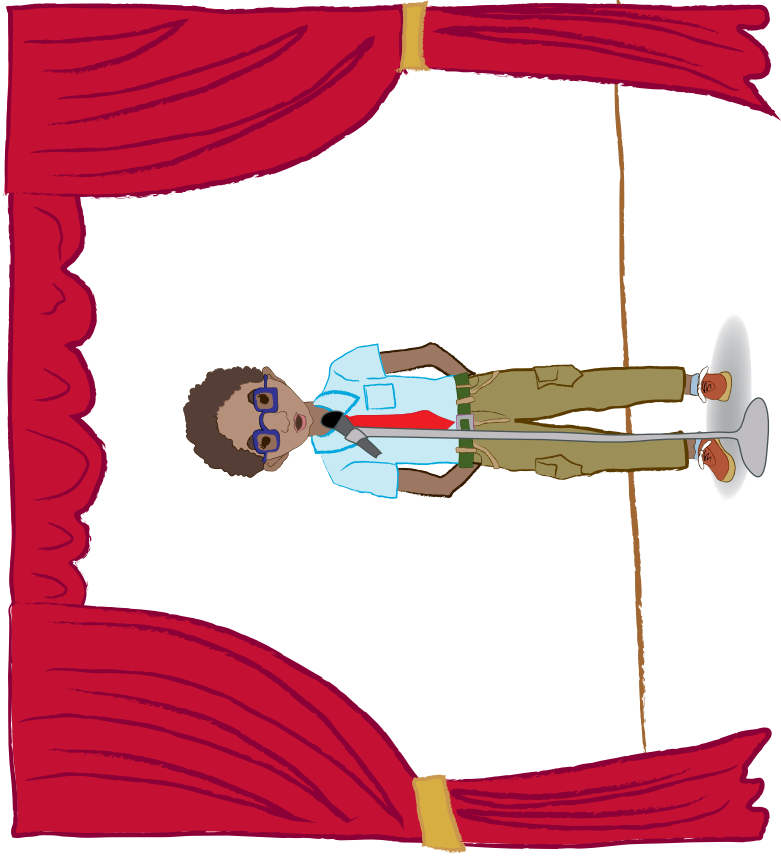
He and the other kids walked
